Jumbo Soft Vine Charcoal : NOT Compressed
General's Jumbo Willow

Soft Compressed Charcoal :
Alphacolor Quartet Char-Kole Squares or similar

Hard Pastel Sticks: NuPastel brand. For Trois Crayon Technique
Recommended Colors:
Ivory #277-P
Burnt Sienna #203_P
Sanguine #213_P

Soft Pastel Sticks (At least two- recommended earth colors or artist preference.)
(Any two large diameter pastel chalks)
Cretacolor Chunky Charcoal Sticks and Sets
Derwent XL Charcoal Blocks and Sets
Richeson Street Stix Pavement Pastels and Sets

Paper:

Drawing Papers: Assorted
Strathmore 400 Series Drawing Paper Pad
Canson Mi-Tientes paper 19" x 25" sheets or pads
Suggested Colors- Moonglow, Flannel Grey, Felt Grey

Materials:

Kneaded Eraser As large as possible.

Chamois Soft goatskin cloth for erasure
Art Supply Store or Auto Parts store sells larger cloth used for car detailing. Can be cut into smaller pieces
Backing Board A rigid backing board upon which the paper is affixed.
WSA has Masonite drawing boards which will require binder clips or a large rubber band to hold the paper in place. Tape can also be used.. Academic Drawing boards have a clip built into the board.
Academic Drawing Boards : available with clips built into the board.
Binder Clips At least two.
Fixative Spray (optional) Spray Workable fixative: A fine varnish spray for dry media that adheres the charcoal to the paper- so you can preserve your drawings
Grumbacher Workable Fixative
Sennelier Delacroix fixative for Charcoal Drawings
