KINDLY BRING EITHER:

One *Fanboy Comic Strip Boards* by Canson Paper Company: 5" X 17": 150 lb with 14 Sheets. Currently, this item sells for \$11.25 at Catskill Art and Office Supply.

or

Prepare your own 14 boards by cutting them all to the dimensions stated above. Boards must be composed of heavy paper, at least 150 lb. Said paper must be able to engage with water media.

KINDLY BRING ALL THE FOLLOWING MATERIALS:

For Notation: Notebook or Paper

8 Pencils: Each one different such as:

Charcoal, Graphite (Hard and Soft), Conté, Carpenters, Colored, water soluble graphite.

1 Ballpoint Pen: Black

1 Hard Eraser

1 Soft ("Kneaded") Eraser

1 Stump

1 Small Sponge

10 Toothpicks

1 Gluestick or Line-Co Adhesive Glue

KINDLY DO BRING SOME OR ALL OF THE FOLLOWING MATERIALS:

Pastels

Watercolors and Brushes

Gouache

Inks

Crayons
