Carving Tools (Japanese tool specific for mokuhanga)

U-gouge Josei Maru To – 18.mm (McClain's C2652) \$50.68

1 - U-gouge Namisei Maru To – 15.mm (McClain's C2818) \$28.24

Kento Nomi (registration tool) \$40.00

Other Tools option – The following woodcutting tools work OK but the tools above are specific for mokuhanga Japanese carving, so you get the best results.

Five pieces woodcarving set (The Japan Woodworker product ID#18C41) \$49.99

Other option: Five-piece carving set - \$23.27- or 7-piece carving set- \$33.50
