### Supply List

6 pre-stretched canvases, 12"x12", gallery-wrap (deep edges).

Watercolor or oil painting paper, 9"x12" or larger, a pad is perfect

Gesso for paper if desired;

Pencil

Ruler

Whatever supplies you plan on using for this workshop if you are using your own techniques/  
medium OR if you are using mine, see below:

(I have bolded items that are important which you might not be familiar with.)

Oil Paints:

Utrecht OR any brand in that range or better is fine, since we will be mixing with a wax medium. I love Williamsburg and Holbein, but build on what you have, and mixing brands is fine.

Essential colors: white, pthalo & ultramarine blue, pthalo or viridian green, cadmium yellow medium (or similar), cadmium red (or similar), alizarin crimson, black (I will demo how to mix any color from these).

Recommended or just plain nice: yellow ochre, burnt sienna, sap green, purple, Payne's grey, Prussian blue, Mars violet, A DEEP black—Old Holland, Williamsberg, Holbein.

**Wax medium: Soho brand**, sold at Catskill Art & Office in Woodstock.

**Art Spectrum Colorfix primer, aubergine** is my favorite, or: deep ultramarine or terracotta (available at Catskill Art & Office or online) and any brand gesso in black.

#### Supply List

**Chip or China brushes** (the super cheap ones with bare wood handles) in a range of sizes, a bunch of the smallest size ( $\frac{1}{2}$ " ), and a few/ea. moving up to 2". Available in hardware stores.

**Filberts in synthetic sable**, for detail, #4-#12 range; a rake/comb & stencil brush are nice (but optional).

Palette (disposable is fine)

Turpenoid Green

Rags or Paper Towels
