THOMPSON FAMILY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- Students in ongoing classes are eligible for full tuition scholarships. New Students are responsible for a one-time \$15 registration fee. All scholarship students are responsible for prompt payments of associated lab and model fees prior to their classes and according to WSA's quarterly payment plan. Registration is NOT complete until student has paid the requisite fees and officially registered with the office.
- Thompson Family Foundation scholarship recipients are expected to attend classes consecutively during enrollment period. If a student cannot attend a class, the registrar (845-679-2388) must be notified prior to class. Students may make up one missed class per month. More than one consecutive missed class may result in discontinuation of scholarship.
- Students who wish to attend a class where a live model is employed must provide written permission from their parent or guardian
- First time scholarship students are awarded a one-month trial scholarship. At the conclusion of the month, if the student's progress and attendance are satisfactory, the scholarship will be extended, and the student will be put on our bi-annual renewal plan.
- Home Schooled students welcome, with parental permission
