# **Cut Paper and Mixed Media**

## Please bring with you:

- Acrylic paints: any colors you would like to use. At a minimum bring white, black, raw sienna, red.
  - For beginners- Michael's sells 4 ounce tubes of "Basics" acrylics for \$7-\$10/tube. These are not the greatest quality but they're good as a starter set.
- 1 pad of paper- recommended: 9" x 12" Canson Mix Media pad or similar\* \*get 86-100 lb. paper (the pad does not need to be specifically for painting. If it's 86-100 lb., this indicates that the paper is heavy enough to paint on)
- 1-2 palette knives: medium size, not too rigid, should have some flexibility.
- Painting palette: made of paper or plastic.
- Brushes, size #8, 10, 12 or similar sizes
- Paint rags/paper towel
- Container for water (such as coffee can or quart yogurt container)
- Scissors

### Any of the following for collage:

- Out-takes of lithos, etchings or discarded drawings, fabric scraps.
- Magazine and newspaper clippings (I recommend that these be run through a xerox machine so the image is on a better quality paper than magazine paper/ newspaper.)

#### **Optional for Mixed Media:**

- Surfaces- Recommended- wooden fine arts boxes sold at Michael's. "Artists Loft- Cradled Wood Painting Panel"- they sell these in 3-packs very affordably. These are smooth, sturdy wood surfaces suitable for painting or gluing and can bear the weight of various mixed media materials.
- Mixed Media materials- Bring in whatever excites you! We can discuss in class what is practical to use. Hot glue guns will be provided as adhesive.

## Included in your lab fee:

- Paper: Heavy 11" x 15" watercolor paper for your gluing surface. You may bring your own surface if you prefer.
- Adhesive: Matte Medium for glue.
