Supplies to bring (The following basic supplies are recommended but student may also bring whatever you normally work with):

- Gesso: jar of basic quality gesso
- Paint: Student's choice of oil or acrylic. Colors: white and primary colors (red, yellow, blue); student's choice of additional colors
- Painting supports: Pad of canvas paper, at least 9 x 12 inches, or larger size, if preferred. Pad-of 140 pound watercolor paper, 9 x 12 inches or larger size if preferred.
- Tools: brushes, medium to large sizes any type
- Painting knives, various sizes
- Paper towels, and/or rags
