### **Supplies to bring:**

- 11x14" or 16x20" pack of canvas
- Large palette 14x18" or bigger, can be a piece of glass taped down to cardboard
- Palette knives
- Pencils and charcoal
- Set of brushes
- 2 mason jars
- Small bottle of Gamsol, Small Bottle of Gamblin Solvent – free fluid, and small bottle of safflower oil.
- Oil Paint: white, red, blue, and yellow. Windsor & Newton make a good quality student brand called "Winton" available in most Art supply shops
- Cloth rags (optional)
