

RANSOME De'collage Supply List

Utility or craft knife (X-acto) with a variety of blades

Ruler (metal is best) for measuring or straight- edge.

Small bowl or some type of container that can hold water.

Brayer

You will need two types of Glue/ adhesives.

1. Elmer's glue -All
2. Nori or YES or Extra Heavy Gel Matte or Mod Podge

Small fine- tip and all-purpose scissors

White artist tape

Support or surfaces for your collages

- Thick Bristol board, cardboard or sheets of illustration board work best. Keep in mind we will be working no larger than 9 x 12", and we may make 3 to 5 collages over the two days, so you don't need a lot.

Scraps of papers (8 ½ x 11 or smaller)

- Found- any papers that you like the pattern of (any size or amount)
- Decorative papers (buy a one or two sheets of decorative paper from your local art store or online. You can also bring gift wrapping or a few magazines or newspapers and junk mail.
- Bring in a drawing pad or sketch book– 9 x 12" or 11x 14", To make your own patterns. Students are welcome make a few patterns before class starts and bring them in, but this is not required.

Bring a few different acrylic paints (any brand or colors)

You may want to bring a surface to cut things on. A small self- healing cutting board or cardboard will due. I'm a scissors person, so I will not need one.

Finally bring your bag of goodies for making.

Crayons, pencils, pens, ink, any type of paints, brushes, pastels, colored pencils, erasers, and other things that I couldn't image you could use to make art with.

The most important thing is to bring yourself, bright eyed and ready to CREATE!

Do not bring: Oil paints, or spray mount.
