Supplies to bring:

- Watercolor Pad, 11x15, 140 lb. paper
- Watercolor paints in tubes or pans. Color suggestions: Alizarin Crimson, Cadmium-free Red, Burnt Sienna, Cadmium-free Yellow, Cobalt or Ultramarine Blue, Sap green.
- Watercolor palette. These palettes have a large mixing tray surrounded by sections for dabs of paint such as a John Pike Palette. You can also use a pie plate or enamel tray with sides.
- Watercolor brushes, one flat and one round.
- Pencil and sketchbook
- Paper towels or cotton rags
- Water container such as a coffee can or 2lb yogurt container

Optional supplies to bring:

- watercolor pencils, fine line markers
