



## Photo Encaustic and Mixed Media

### Supplies to bring:

- A few panels coated with encaustic gesso, or other appropriate surface for encaustic paint. Cradled panels, or simple flat wood panels will work as long as they are not coated with acrylic gesso (encaustic gesso or white milk paint will work).

**Note:** You can get your initial encausticbord panels at an art store. WSA School Store has a limited supply of Ampersand Encausticbord available for students who need additional panels during the actual workshop. <https://ampersandart.com/panels/encausticbord>

- Apron
- Clean simple chip brushes (1&½" or 2" wide)

### Optional supplies to bring:

- Fan brush for encaustic medium
- Typical favorite drawing or mark making tools, pencils, etc
- Collage materials; old drawings, letters, book pages, prints, or any absorbent thin material
