



## Low Toxicity Solvents that are Allowed at WSA:

- [Grumbacher Grumtine](#) (may be used as both a solvent and thinner/medium)
- [Eco House Xtra Mild Citrus Thinner](#) (may be used as both a solvent and thinner/medium)
- [Chelsea Classical Studio Lavender Spike Oil Essence Solvent](#) (may be used as both a solvent and thinner/medium)
- [Solvent-Free Painting Mediums](#) (may be used as medium)
- [The Masters Brush Cleaner and Preserver](#)
- [Gamblin Gamsol Odorless Mineral Spirits](#) (may be used as both a solvent and thinner/medium) (Gamsol is a petroleum distillate but all the aromatic solvents have been refined out of it, less than .005% remains. Aromatic solvents are the most harmful types of petroleum solvents - [Learn More](#))
- You may use linseed oil, safflower oil, poppy oil, walnut oil or any other oil or medium which does not contain turpentine, mineral spirits, petroleum distillates, white spirits, naptha, etc. for thinner.

***Absolutely no turpentine or mineral spirits (besides Gamblin Gamsol Odorless Mineral Spirits) are to be used in the studios. Additionally, please refrain from wearing perfume, cologne or scents of any kind.***

***No solvents are allowed down the sink, the best type of containers to store solvents for brush cleaning is either glass or metal jars with a sealed top. It is recommended to use jars with a screen which allows pigment to settle on the bottom of the jar such as [Silicoil Brush Cleaning Tanks](#). Mark all jars and cans containing solvents with appropriate labels.***
