Brushes – at least 3 round watercolor brushes

Small (# 0-3) Medium (#4-5) Larger (#6-8)

Paper: You will probably make 2 or 3 prints so 1 piece of paper of your choice:

Fabriano Rospina OR

Shin-Torinoko - White 24.75" x 37.5" (iMcClains)

Included in your lab fee: 1 8x10 Shina Plywood Wood block 3/8 (iMcClains) -
You will be able to use both sides. Tracing paper, tape, transfer paper, paper
towels, rags, and newsprint.

The first print will take up about 4 x 6 on your board. After that, the size you
create is your choice based on the board and paper you have left.
